2. Project should include:

- a. Name of the disasters, their consequences and management.
- b. What steps should be taken in advance to face such situations.
- c. How to create awareness and preparedness among the community.

4. It is to be noted here by all the students that the projects and models prepared should be made from eco-friendly products without incurring too much expenditure.

5. The Project Report can be handwritten or digital.

6. The Project work can culminate in the form of Power Point Presentation/albums/files/song and dance or culture show /story. Students can include the success story of particular communities in managing the disasters like how coastal areas of Odisha dealing with giant cyclones almost every year.

10. The project work should also include creative ideas of the students about how to successfully mitigate the disasters or about sustainable lifestyle which will help in reducing such disasters which will help in enhancing the Life Skills of the students.

11. If possible, various forms of art may be integrated in the project work.

Activity/activities:

1. Students need to draw a world map in a chart paper and trace the course of World War I. The place(country) from where War broke out and which places and countries got involved in the war from the period of 1914 to 1918.

2. Students need to draw a world map in a chart paper and trace the course of World War II. The place(country) from where War broke out and which places and countries got involved in the war from the period of 1939 to 1945.
